

The purpose of the Activity Program at CPA is to facilitate **intentional relationship building between the faculty and students** through engaging in activities of common interests. Through these activities, students and faculty interact with one another in a wide variety of interests that include offerings from honor societies and service organizations to recreation and all things in between.

Activity Choices for 2012-2013

A-Day Activities:

Activity: **Jazz Lounge**, Sponsor: John Barlow (A-Day)

This club will explore the world of jazz listening to it's early beginnings up to modern jazz. Each week we will select a jazz theme or artist to listen to, followed by discussion. Students will be strongly encouraged to bring in their own jazz mixes to share with the rest of the club.

Activity: **All Year Olympics**, Sponsor: Dan Carpenter (A-Day)
