The areas of digital citizenship about which students learn are:

- Etiquette: standards of conduct and procedure
- Communication: exchange of information
- Education: about technology or how to use a technology
- Access: full participation in society using technology
- Commerce: buying and selling of goods using technology
- Responsibility: for actions done using technology
- Rights: freedoms extended to everyone in a digital world
- Safety: physical, emotional and spiritual well-being in a digital world
- Security: electronic precautions that promote personal safety
